



Tailoring

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Although JAC databases are designed to meet the requirements of most clients, it may be necessary to tailor the system to meet the specific needs of a client.

Where tailoring is required, a specification is drawn up after JAC meet with all interested parties. This specification is then signed off and the system is designed and implemented.

Each specification is analysed and ongoing development meetings are held to discuss the progress of the project, with milestones included within the plan.

From the specification to completion, full checks are made to ensure that the database meets the criteria and is presented correctly to the users.

We will design databases for any reason and most recently we have developed a new set of options for our report / query writer.

If the customer requests that the source code remains the property of the client, JAC will incorporate this into a one off initial charge and the software will become the property of the client. (As long as it is not sold) This enables the client to take control of the system should anything happen to JAC.

Ongoing tailoring can also be incorporated so that changes to the system can be minimised and the down time decreased.
