The Injured Jockeys Fund

CHARITease and BENEFICIARease were implemented during 2006, transferring the information from an old Fundraising and Grant Management system. SQL Server 2005 was introduced and in excess of 500,000 records were transferred with a clean up of addresses using the Royal Mail ListCleaner service. A trading system was also developed which controls over £900,000 of trading income per year. BENEFICIARease is now in use by 7 remote sites throughout the UK



Racing Welfare

CHARITease was implemented in 2004 with BENEFICIARease embedded within the database so that all aspects of the organisation can be viewed from one location. Data was transferred from AppealMaster. New routines for property / tenancy and waiting lists were developed. Recently, the database has been rolled out to 6 remote sites throughout the UK.



The Ironbridge Gorge Museum Development Trust

CHARITease was introduced in 2003 to handle all Fundraising and Gift Aid. Since then, £470,840.88 has been claimed in Gift Aid. Most recently a SQL server version was introduced to cope with over 120,000 records. Routines were written for labels and reports for Business Club members and Livery companies which are specific to Ironbridge.
